



New pedestrian entrance on Carterhall Lane with dry stone wall along boundary enhances rural character. Robust timber posts and motorbike barrier. 'Charnock Recreation Ground' carved into posts. £15,000

Car park resurfaced and marked out for 30 cars with an 'in and out' circulation. A segregated pedestrian route along side the car park to improve safety. New pedestrian entrance into the park from car park with cycle barrier as other pedestrian entrances. Dry stone wall to boundary to follow through the rural theme. £75,000



Pedestrian entrance on Arnold Avenue with motor bike barrier and new tarmac footpath £7,000



Robust picnic benches £8,000



Play Area extended with more equipment. Possible low dry-stone wall around. New pedestrian entrances away from vehicles for safety £139,000



New multi-games area marked out for 5-a-side football and basketball. Screen planting to reduce impact in Green belt. Planning permission required. £90,000



Wetland habitat area developed with board walk paths and picnic tables £30,000

Amphitheatre built into slope with boulders for scrambling over. Educational resource for school and other groups £10,000



Community orchard with fruit trees £2,000



New robust timber field gate to vehicular entrance. Adjacent pedestrian entrance with motorbike barrier £10,000

Habitat Areas improved along this boundary incorporating log heaps, long grass, additional tree planting and wild flowers £12,000

Drainage ditch along Carterhall Lane cleared out £8,000

Junior pitch: re-graded and drainage system installed, discharging to the wetland area. £50,000

Maze Mown into long grass

Football pitch: drainage system installed, discharging to habitat areas £30,000

Various informal play features with mown grass paths through long grass areas. £10,000

'Play' equipment for older people located around the fitness circuit £15,000



Wild flowers £10,000

Crushed brick paths around the recreation ground in keeping with the rural character and providing a fitness circuit as well as links to the various facilities. Mown strips adjacent to paths through long grass areas. Litter bins, dog bins and robust timber seats located around the paths £55,000
